During this period, the INFLIBNET Centre deployed its free ILMS service for 04 institutions including Sri Sri Aniruddhadeva Sports University, Dibrugarh, Assam; Sikkim University, Gangtok; Babasaheb Bhimrao Ambedkar University, Lucknow and Gujarat University, Ahmedabad.

इस कोविड-१६ महामारी अवधि के दौरान, इनिफलबनेट सेंटर ने अल्पकालिक और दीर्घकालिक ऑनलाइन प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम और वेबिनार आयोजित करने के लिए कई पहल की हैं। इस रिपोर्ट अवधि के दौरान, केंद्र ने ४ – ८ जनवरी २०२१, १५ – १६ फरवरी २०२१ और २२ – २६ मार्च २०२१ के दौरान क्रमशः *SOUL 2-0 की स्थापना और संचालन' पर तीन ऑनलाइन प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम आयोजित किए। केंद्र ने दो ऑनलाइन प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रमः २७ – २६ जनवरी २०२१ के दौरान "अनुसंधान मुल्यांकन और अनुसंधान सहायता उपकरण" पर तीन दिवसीय ऑनलाइन प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम, और १ – ५ फरवरी २०२१ के दौरान "बिब्लियोमेट्रिक एंड रिसर्च आउटपुट एनालिसिस" पर पांच–दिवसीय ऑनलाइन उन्नत प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम आयोजित किए । केंद्र ने ८ मार्च २०२१ को एन-लिस्ट के माध्यम से उपलब्ध लर्निंग और रिसर्च के लिए ईबीएससीओ ई-संसाधनों (एचडब्ल्यू विल्सन) की खोज पर एक ऑनलाइन प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रम आयोजित किया। इसके अलावा, केंद्र ने इस रिपोर्ट अवधि के दौरान शैक्षणिक और अनुसंधान से संबंधित विभिन्न विषयों पर ०३ ऑनलाइन वेबिनार आयोजित किए। केंद्र ने अपने सभी स्टाफ सदस्यों और उनके परिवार के साथ केंद्र परिसर में २६ जनवरी २०२१ को ७२ वां गणतंत्र दिवस मनाया।

Five-day Online Advanced Training Programme on "Bibliometric and Research Output Analysis", INFLIBNET Centre, Gandhinagar, 1st – 5th February 2021

The INFLIBNET Centre organized an Online Advanced Training Programme on "Bibliometric and Research Output Analysis" from 01st to 05th February 2021 through online mode. 100 participants attended the training programme. The training programme provided a sound overview of bibliometric methods, bibliometric data sources, data processing and performance indicators related to bibliometric analysis and mapping. It

also provided awareness of the most commonly used databases, i.e. Web of Science and Scopus. Special emphasis was given to advanced network analysis, interpretation and visualization of data, including the theoretical sessions on various tools such as VOS Viewer, etc. The programme also introduced R language, for the analysis of various bibliometric indicators, and Biblioshiny, GUI for bibliometric analysis.

The entire online programme was moderated by Dr Kruti Trivedi and Mr Hitesh Solanki. Details of the lectures delivered by experts during the training programme were as follows:



Then, Hon'ble Chief Guest, Prof D P Singh launched SOUL 3.0





Current Status of INFLIBNET Projects

Shodhganga

Shodhganga: a repository of full-text theses in Indian Universities has grown progressively during the period under report. As on 31st March 2021, 596 universities + CFTIs have signed MoU on Shodhganga with the INFLIBNET Centre where 12 MoUs were added during the period. The total number of theses deposited in the repository has grown up to 2,99,500+ deposited by the contribution by 490+ Universities.

Figure-1 shows the Theses uploaded during January-March is 8261 whereas the total Theses

submitted to the repository has reached at 2,99,500.

ShodhShuddhi and Plagiarism Detection Software (PDS)

The Ministry of Education through its initiative ShodhShuddhi provides access to Plagiarism Detection Software (PDS) to all universities including Central, State, Deemed and Private Universities, as well as Centrally funded Technical Institutions (CFTIs) in India through Central funding to enhance academic integrity in academic institutions and to curb plagiarism, w.e.f. 01 September, 2019. This program was launched by the Hon'ble Minister of Education during the CABE meeting in Vigyan Bhavan, New Delhi and it is being executed by INFLIBNET Centre, Gandhinagar.

As on 31st March 2021, a total of 11,15,743 documents have been submitted for checking the Plagiarism by 1,05,765 users from 776 Universities/institutions. The rest of the Universities/institutions are either using any other

software or research programmes have not yet started there.

URKUND Becomes Ouriginal on 15th March 2021 and new Webinbox released on 15th March 2021

Along with the merger of the PlagScan Antiplagiarism Software with URKUND, the name & brand of URKUND is now permanently changed to Ouriginal on 15th March 2021 (https://www.ouriginal.com/). Ouriginal brings together the combined expertise of Urkund and PlagScan's plagiarism detection, spanning over three decades to promote academic integrity and help prevent plagiarism.

As part of this merger and the subsequent rebranding, it has also released an updated interface of the Webinbox. There are no changes to the existing product that Universities are using today, except that users will have access to login to the new Webinbox interface. At the same time, all users will have access to continue using the existing Webinbox interface.

One key feature that is new and added to the new Webinbox as per the request from INFLIBNET

Centre and the associated Universities/institutions is having the option for receiver users to delete documents. This is one of few selected new functionalities added to the new Webinbox interface.

The Plagiarism Detection Software (URKUND now renamed as Ouriginal) has been provided to all identified 1040 Universities/Institutions by creating a user ID and Password for each University Coordinators (UC) with admin rights.

Afterwards of the lockdown relaxation in July

2020, submission into PDS has increased as researchers and students are gradually coming back to research and academic activities. Figure-4 shows the average number of submissions in the last 3 months (January-February-March 2021), and the average was 68,924. And, Figure-5 shows the number of documents submitted for plagiarism check from January to March 2021.




Figure-4: No. of Submissions in PDS month-wise (January-March 2021)




Figure-5: No. of Documents Submitted for Plagiarism Check (January-March 2021)




Figure-6: No. of Users added monthly

The graph (Figure-6) shows the total number of users created/added in ShodhShuddhi to date are 1,05,765 whereas the number of users added monthly ((January-February-March 2021)) are as follows (January = 2063, February = 1128 and March = 1006). PDS has a provision for 3 Lakhs users from all Universities.

INFLIBNET Learning Management Service

INFLIBNET Learning Management Service (ILMS) is a service offered by the Information and Library Network Centre (An IUC of UGC) to institutions of higher education across the country. This


