DataCite Global Access Fund (DataCite-GAF)


The INFLIBNET Centre was awarded the DataCite Global Access Funds (DataCite-GAF) in December 2023 to conduct outreach programmes. This award is a testament to the INFLIBNET Centre's organizational expertise and commitment to advancing research data management practices and promoting open science. The Outreach Programme aims to raise awareness, provide training, and inculcate the adoption of Open Science among researchers, institutions, and stakeholders across diverse academic disciplines. Through this initiative, the Centre will work collaboratively with the research community to enhance data discoverability, accessibility, and interoperability, thereby facilitating more efficient and impactful research outcomes. The project aims to conduct Six Webinars, Six onsite Regional Capacity Building Programmes, and one train-the-trainer programme at the INFLIBNET Centre. During the reported period, the first webinar, "Unleashing the Potential of Open Research Data Management," was conducted on 22nd March 2024, and around 125 participants actively participated in it.

Launching of "SheRNI: She Research Network in India" Portal

The Hon'ble Director, INFLIBNET Centre proudly launched 'SheRNI: She Research Network in India' on the occasion of International Women's Day 2024. empowers women by providing collaboration, mentorship, and knowledge-sharing opportunities. This project aims to create a national-level expert profile system for women faculty members and facilitate the exchange of expertise, insights, and experiences among women experts in diverse fields.

Key Features of the She Research Network in India (SheRNI)

Funding and Grants: To support research initiatives on women's issues, the platform features information on funding opportunities, grants, and scholarships available to researchers and organizations. This ensures equitable access to resources for conducting gender-responsive research.

Events and Workshops: SheRNI serves as a hub for information on conferences, seminars, workshops, and other events related to women's studies. Users can stay updated on upcoming events, submit proposals, and participate in discussions to enhance their knowledge and skills.

Recognition of Excellence: Each month, the SheRNI platform will select and showcase a remarkable woman professional who has demonstrated excellence, innovation, and leadership

in her respective field. This feature provides a platform to recognize and celebrate the achievements of women who are making significant contributions to research, academia, and society.

Inspirational Stories: The "Women of the Month" feature on SheRNI presents inspirational stories and profiles of selected women professionals, highlighting their academic journey, research accomplishments, career milestones, and impact on their communities. These stories serve as a source of inspiration and empowerment for other women professionals, encouraging them to pursue their goals and aspirations.

Current Status of INFLIBNET Projects

Shodh-Chakra: A Gateway to Researchers for Resources

Shodh-Chakra is an initiative of the INFLIBNET Centre under the guidance of UGC to help the academic community during their research life cycle. Shodh-Chakra provides a unique space for the researcher, guide/supervisor, and university to manage the research lifecycle of a research scholar. The portal is integrated with millions of resources (including full-text theses) and the helping tools for the researcher, which are required during the research work. A total of 119 Universities have already signed MoU with the INFLIBNET Centre to use Shodh-Chakra including 15 Universities that have signed MoU during the reported period. As approved by the Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, the INFLIBNET Centre, Gandhinagar has been given the task of managing and executing its day-to-day activities, including registration, applications and allotment of ISBN as well as technical maintenance of the ISBN Portal. During the reported period (01st January to 31st March 2024), 3,341 stakeholders registered on the ISBN portal where 8,564 applications were received, and 1,22,292 ISBNs were allotted to the stakeholders/ Publishers.

VIDWAN and Indian Research Information Network System (IRINS)

VIDWAN database contains detailed profiles of more than 2,37,946 faculty members and scientists working in 19,506 academic institutions till the reported period. IRINS is a web-based Research Information Management (RIM) service provided to higher education institutions in

India by the INFLIBNET Centre. IRINS facilitates academic, R&D organizations, faculty members, and scientists to collect, curate, and showcase scholarly communication activities and provides an opportunity to create a scholarly network. The INFLIBNET Centre has created 1,148 IRINS instances for Institutions until the reported period including 66 IRINS instances created during the period under report. IRINS has connected 182,691 faculty members through this project. The project retrieved 25.22 lakhs+ (25,22,117) publications metadata from various sources, received 229 lakhs+ (2,29,77,539) citations, and 91.7 lakhs+ (91,74,139) of Altmetrics mentions until the reported period.

National Portal for Transgender Persons (TG Portal)

Under an MoU with the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Department of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India, the INFLIBNET Centre has developed the 'National Portal for Transgender Persons.' The portal enables a transgender person to digitally apply for a certificate and identity card from anywhere in the country without visiting any office. The Centre has continued the services as per the MoU. The table below shows the statistics about the number of applications received, certificates and ID cards issued, etc., during the reported period.

Shodhganga: A Reservoir of Indian Theses

The first quarter of 2024 is marked as a remarkable period for Shodhganga, and carve-in PhD Theses mark its growth from most renewed national institutions like IITs/IIMs/NITs, etc. Shodhganga, a repository of full-text theses in Indian universities, has grown progressively, with a total of 19,427 Theses uploaded during the period under report, i.e., January-March 2024.

As such, till 31st March 2024, a total of 886 (780 Universities+106 CFTIs/INIs) have signed MoUs on Shodhganga, with the INFLIBNET Centre, including 21 MoUs (20 Universities+01 CFTIs/INIs) during the reported period, increasing the number of full-text theses in Shodhganga. As such, the repository has grown progressively during the period under the report.

The total number of theses deposited in the Shodhganga repository has grown to 5,25,293+ by the contribution of 765 contributing Universities.




Figure 1: Theses uploaded to Shodhganga

The total theses uploaded (Figure 1) in the Quarter-Q1 (January-March 2024) are 19,427.

Shodhgangotri

Shodhgangotri is also now open to PG dissertations based on the request from the Ministry of Ayush. Currently, the repository hosts 13,657 Synopses/SHPs/PDFs/Fellowships/PG Dissertations contributed by 124 universities. During the reported period, 433 Synopses/SHPs/PDFs/Fellowship/PG Dissertations were added.

ShodhShuddhi and Plagiarism Detection Software (PDS)

The Ministry of Education through its initiative ShodhShuddhi provides access to Plagiarism Detection Software (PDS) to all Universities including Central, State, Deemed, and Private Universities, as well as Centrally funded Technical Institutions/Institutes of National Importance (CFTIs/INIs) in India through Central funding to enhance academic integrity in academic institutions and to curb plagiarism, w.e.f. o1st September 2019. In October 2023, a new PDS Software (i.e., DrillBit Extreme) was procured and provided to 1100+ HEIs.

As of 31st March 2024, a total of 41,88,218 documents have been submitted for checking for similarity/plagiarism from 1137 (799 active) Universities/Institutions since inception. The Project Shodhshuddhi envisaged using 10 Lakhs of documents each year, and now 41.88 Lakhs of documents are submitted till the end of 31st March 2024. A total of 1,72,755 users migrated to the new PDS Software.

Usage Statistics of PDS during the period under report




Figure 3: No. of Active Users during the period

The total submission of documents to PDS during the period under report is 3,49,631. Figure 2 shows the average number of submissions in the last three months (January=113297, February=119070, and March=117264); the average was 1,16,543. Figure 3 shows the monthwise addition of users. A total of 16,536 new users were added during the period under report in PDS.

Figure 2: No. of Submissions in PDS month-wise (January-March 2024)
