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From Director's Desk



Dear Readers

I am glad to present the final quarter issue of the INFLIBNET Newsletter for 2024. As we reach the end of 2024, I take this opportunity to reflect on the incredible journey we have made together at the INFLIBNET Centre over the past year with continuous innovation, improvement, achievement, and collaboration. We are even more committed now and dedicated to supporting, developing and managing information resources and services to enhance libraries, research and education in India.

Throughout the year, we have made significant progress in all our projects, activities and initiatives, catering to the needs of the country's library, research and academic communities. Through various international projects, collaborations, and outreach programmes, we have enhanced our services, improved access to scholarly resources, promoted open access to research data for open science, and realised our goals.

The INFLIBNET Centre signed an MoU with Rani Channamma University (RCUB), Belagavi, on 14th October 2024, to implement the INFLIBNET services at RCUB through INFLIBNET Research Corner and enhance access to essential research services by the University academic and research community.

Until the reported period, the Centre has created 1,421 IRINS instances for institutions, including 106 IRINS instances created during the reported period, and has connected 2,16,112 faculty members through this project. A total of 145 universities signed up for MoU with the INFLIBNET Centre until the reported period to use Shodh-Chakra, including 06 universities that signed up for MoU during the period under report. The number of theses deposited into the Shodhganga repository has grown to 5,76,731 + , with 16,914 theses uploaded during the reported period. 942 (832 Universities + 110 CFTIs/INIs) have signed MoUs on Shodhganga with the INFLIBNET Centre, including 15 MoUs (13 Universities + 02 CFTIs) during the reported period. Further, as per the recommendation by the newly constituted Shodhganga National Steering Committee (SNSC), the Centre is working towards revamping Shodhganga and testing the migration process from the current/existing Dspace 5.3 to 7.6.1. Also, we have made amendments to the current MoU for Shodhganga with necessary amendments to deal with the embargo and the License/Copyright issues of theses.

During the reported period, as far as the allotment of ISBNs through the ISBN portal is concerned, a total of 3,276 stakeholders registered on the ISBN portal, where 10,405 applications were received, and 1,52,724 ISBNs were allotted to the stakeholders/Publishers.

The INFLIBNET Centre regularly conducts offline/online specialised training programmes and workshops to train participants from different institutions nationwide. During the reported quarter, the Centre conducted two five-day training programmes (25th Online and 171st Offline) on "SOUL 3.0: Installation and Operations" from 21st–25th October 2024, and 25th-29th November 2024, respectively. Three (03) specialised training programmes: one five-day National Workshop on Cloud Technology for Educational Institutions from 18th-22nd November 2024, one five-day Advanced Training Programme on Bibliometric and Research Output Analysis from 2nd-6th December 2024, and a three-day Research Information Management System (RIMS) workshop from 11th-13th December 2024, were organised at the INFLIBNET Centre, Gandhinagar. The Centre conducted one INFLIBNET Regional Training Programme on Library Automation (IRTPLA-2024) jointly organised with Career College (Autonomous) Bhopal from 18th to 22nd November 2024. Further, during the reported period, the Centre conducted 02 institutional training programmes on Shodh-Chakra and 02 training programmes on ILMS.

As part of the ORCID Global Participation Fund awarded last July 2023, the INFLIBNET Centre conducted a One-day User Awareness Programme on ORCID and INFLIBNET Services for Scholarly Communities" at Visvesvaraya National Institute of Technology (VNIT), Nagpur, Maharashtra on 25th October 2024. Also, as part of the awarded DataCite Global Access Funds (DataCite-GAF) last December 2023, the Centre conducted one in-person Train-the-Trainer Program: Three Days Workshop on Open Research Data Management from 07th–09th October 2024 at the Centre, two webinars on 23rd October 2024, and 14th November 2024, respectively, and six one-day-awareness programme on Research Data Management (RDM), under RDM outreach programmes at different HEIs during the reported period.

The INFLIBNET Centre celebrated the Navratri festival with great enthusiasm, with a Garba night organised on 7th October 2024, for its employees and their families. Also, a free Ayurveda Treatment Diagnosis camp was organised with Government Ayurvedic Hospital, Gandhinagar's support for INFLIBNET staff members on 16th October 2024. The Centre observed Vigilance Awareness Week 2024 from 28th October 2024 to 3rd November 2024, with the "Culture of Integrity for Nation's Prosperity" theme. In this regard, a vigilance awareness programme was organised on 30th October 2024, in the Auditorium of the Centre, where all employees and staff members participated in and took the vigilance pledge.

The feedback we have received from academic and research institutions across the country not only motivates us to do more, but we continue to refine our activities and services, exploring new avenues to support students, researchers, librarians, and educators alike. However, our achievements would not be possible without the collective effort and unwavering dedication of our staff/team members. I extend my heartfelt gratitude to all of them for their hard work and contributions. INFLIBNET Regional Training Programmes on Library Automation (IRTPLA)

INFLIBNET Regional Training Programme on Library Automation (IRTPLA), Career College, Bhopal, 18th - 22nd November 2024

INFLIBNET Regional Training Programme on Library Automation (IRTPLA-2024) was jointly organised by Career College (Autonomous) Bhopal and the INFLIBNET Centre, Gandhinagar, Gujarat, from 18th to 22nd November 2024. The Programme was inaugurated by Padma Sh Vijay Dutt Shridhar, Founder Director, Madhavrao Sapre Sangrahalaya, Bhopal, MP, on 18th

November 2024 at Career College (Autonomous) Bhopal. Dr Charanjit Kaur, Principal of Career College, gave the welcome address. She highlighted the importance of the programme and extended her best wishes to all the participants. The INFLIBNET Centre and Career College collaboration was also acknowledged during this session.

Mrs Hema Cholin, Scientist-B (LS), INFLIBNET Centre, Gandhinagar, Gujarat, in her address, informed the participants about the activities and services of the INFLIBNET Centre and gave an overview of the IRTPLA programme. She elaborated on INFLIBNET's activities and services, including promoting information science, digital library services, library networking efforts, library management software, digital distribution of educational resources, and online platforms for library networking. The Chief Guest, Sh Shridharji, highlighted the significance of library automation and SOUL 3.0. He emphasised how technological advancements and automation in libraries can improve resource management. He commended Career College for organising the Training Programme and encouraged all participants to make the most of the new technological tools. A formal vote of thanks was proposed by the Group Director of Career College, Professor Pradeep Jain, who expressed his gratitude to the INFLIBNET Centre and all the organisers for their support in making the training programme a success and

emphasised the importance of the programme.

Mrs Hema Cholin, Scientist B (LS) and Sh Vijaykumar Shrimali, Scientist B (CS), were the resource persons from the INFLIBNET Centre. All sessions were focused on the SOUL 3.0 Modules. Participants were introduced to the theoretical aspects of each module, followed by a hands-on session where participants practically applied their learning. A few guest lectures were organised during the training programme. Dr P.K. Tripathi (Regional Institute of Education, Bhopal) delivered an inspiring talk on "Open Educational Resources (OERs)", emphasising their importance in modern education. He explained how OERs promote lifelong learning and contribute to democratising education. He also highlighted libraries' role in providing access to OERs and integrating them into the broader educational system. Sh Mohit Gupta (National Law Institute University, Bhopal) spoke on "Innovative and Emerging Technologies in Library Services." He discussed technological advancements such as cloud computing, artificial intelligence, and digital repositories and how

libraries are adopting these innovations to improve service delivery, enhance user experience, and simplify administrative tasks. Dr Sanjeev Saraf, Deputy Librarian at Dr Hari Singh Gour University, emphasised the need for libraries to evolve and innovate in their services. He explained that libraries are no longer just places for storing and circulating books but must transform into information hubs where knowledge exchange, research, and teaching can flourish through new methods.

The training programme concluded with an

interactive session where participants raised questions, shared thoughts, and clarified their doubts about the features of SOUL 3.0 and emerging technologies like AI in library systems.

In the Valedictory Session, 67 participants were honoured for actively participating in the five-day programme. Feedback was collected from all participants to understand their thoughts and experiences during the training programme. Certificates were distributed, formally recognising their commitment to learning and engagement.

RDM Outreach - DataCite Global Access Fund

As part of the awarded DataCite Global Access Funds (DataCite-GAF) last December 2023, the INFLIBNET Centre conducted the following one in-person Train-the-Trainer Program: Three Days Workshop on Open Research Data Management, two webinars, and six one-day-awareness programme on Research Data Management (RDM), under RDM outreach programmes.

The INFLIBNET Centre organised an in-person Train-the-Trainer Program: Three Days Workshop on Open Research Data Management, from 07th –09th October 2024 at the Centre. Prof Devika P. Madalli, Director, INFLIBNET Centre, inaugurated the workshop on 07th October 2024. A nationwide online survey was conducted to shortlist the participants, inviting all the interested professionals to attend the programme at the INFLIBNET Centre. The survey was started on 25th June 2024, and a total of 143 professionals participated in it. Based on the predefined criteria, 35 participants were selected. One participant from each institution was

selected to give equal opportunity to all the participants. However, 27 participants could attend the programme organised at the Centre. All the participants were provided learning materials, free accommodation, and food during the programme at the INFLIBNET Centre.

The workshop was designed to empower faculty members, researchers, and librarians in HEIs to cascade knowledge on research data management practices and equip them with the skills and knowledge to manage open research data at their institutions effectively.

New Project/Initiative - One Nation One Subscription (ONOS)

The Union Cabinet approved One Nation One Subscription (ONOS) initiative as a Central Sector Scheme on 25th November 2024. ONOS is aimed at providing access to scholarly research e-journals from prominent publishers covering the disciplines of STEM, medical, management, social sciences and humanities.

In his address to the Nation from the ramparts of the Red Fort on 15th August 2022, the Prime Minister of India had pointed out the importance of Research and Development in our country in the Amrit Kaal. He had given the clarion call of "**Jai Anusandhan**" on the occasion. The National Education Policy 2020 (NEP 2020) has also identified research as a corequisite for outstanding education and development in our country.

In response to the vision of making India Atmanirbhar and Viksitbharat@2047, the Government of India approved One Nation One Subscription (ONOS) scheme to provide country-wide access to international high-impact scholarly research articles and journal publications to students, faculty and researchers of all Higher Education Institutions managed by the central government and state governments and Research & Development Institutions of the central government.

One Nation One Subscription (ONOS) intends to acquire national licenses for e-journal/database subscriptions from the most prominent journal publishers. A total of 30 major international journal publishers have been included in ONOS. All the journals published by these publishers will be accessible to the participating institutions' students, faculty members and researchers. The initiative will open a goldmine of knowledge available in top-quality scholarly journals to nearly 1.8 crore students, faculty members, researchers and scientists of all disciplines, including those in tier 2 and tier 3 cities, thereby encouraging core as well as interdisciplinary research in the country.

ONOS will start its operation on 1st January 2025. ONOS phase-I has been approved for the calendar years 2025, 2026 and 2027. The INFLIBNET Centre, Gandhinagar, an Autonomous IUC (Inter-University Centre) of UGC, has been designated as the implementation and executing agency for ONOS by the Core Committee to oversee its implementation. Access to the journals will be made available through the campus IP address of the institute or outside campus through the INFED Access Federation set up at INFLIBNET. The resources can be accessed through any device, including mobiles. The Department of Higher Education, Government of India, will have a unified portal, "One Nation One Subscription" (<https://www.onos.gov.in/>) through which the institutions will be able to access the journals. The ANRF will periodically review the usage of One Nation One Subscription and publications of Indian authors of these institutions.

One Nation One Subscription is a timely step towards establishing India in the global research ecosystem by bringing ease of doing research to the doorstep of all students, faculty members and researchers in government institutions.

Current Status of INFLIBNET Projects

Shodh-Chakra: A Gateway to Researchers for Resources

Shodh-Chakra is an initiative of the INFLIBNET Centre under the guidance of UGC to help the academic community during their research life cycle. Shodh-Chakra provides a unique space for the researcher, guide/supervisor, and University to manage the research lifecycle of a research scholar. The portal is integrated with millions of resources (including full-text theses) and the tools that are required for the researcher during the research work. A total of 145 universities have already signed an MoU with the INFLIBNET Centre to use Shodh-Chakra, including 06 universities that signed up for MoU during the reported period. International Standard Book Number (ISBN)

As approved by the Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, the INFLIBNET Centre, Gandhinagar has been given the task of managing and executing its day-to-day activities, including registration, applications and allotment of ISBN as well as technical maintenance of the ISBN Portal. During the reported period (01st October 2024 to 31st December 2024), 3,276 stakeholders registered on the ISBN portal, where 10,405 applications were received, and 1,52,724 ISBNs were allotted to the stakeholders/Publishers.

VIDWAN and Indian Research Information Network System (IRINS)

VIDWAN database contains detailed profiles of more than 2,73,321 faculty members till the reported period. IRINS, the web-based Research Information Management (RIM) service provided to higher education institutions in India by the INFLIBNET Centre, facilitates academic, R&D organisations, faculty members, and scientists to collect, curate, and showcase scholarly communication activities and provides an opportunity to create a scholarly network. The INFLIBNET Centre has created 1,421 IRINS instances for institutions until the reported period, including 106 IRINS instances created during the period under report. IRINS has connected 2,16,112 faculty members through this project. The project retrieved 28.80 lakhs + (29,87,734) publications metadata from various sources, received 262 lakhs+ (2,62,70,809) citations, and 103.35 lakhs+ (1,03,35,241) of Altmetrics mentions until the reported period.

National Portal for Transgender Persons (TG Portal)

Under an MoU with the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Department of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India, the INFLIBNET Centre has developed the 'National Portal for Transgender Persons.' The portal enables a transgender person to digitally apply for a certificate and identity card from anywhere in the country without visiting any office. The Centre has continued providing services as per the MoU. The table below shows the statistics about the number of applications received, certificates and ID cards issued, etc., during the reported period.

Shodhganga: A Reservoir of Indian Theses

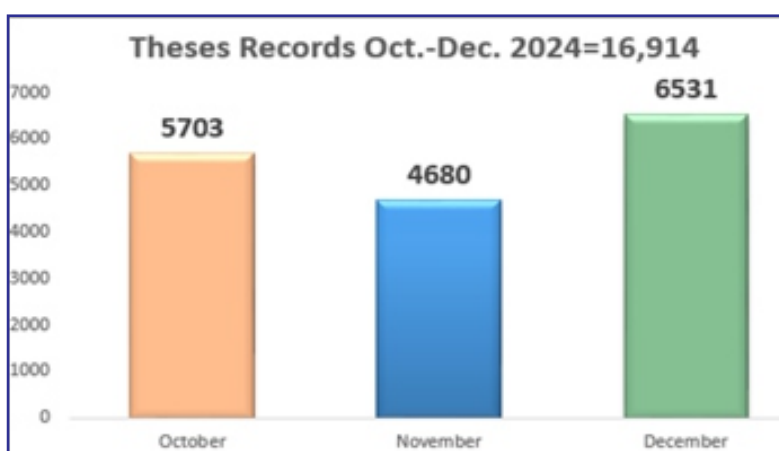


Figure 1: Theses uploaded to Shodhganga

The fourth quarter of the year 2024 is marked as a remarkable period for Shodhganga, and its growth is marked by carve-in PhD Theses from Universities/CFTIs/INIs and testing of upgradations of the Shodhganga. Shodhganga, a repository of full-text theses in Indian Universities, has grown progressively with a total of 5,76,731 Full-text Theses and 16,914 Theses uploaded during the period under report, i.e. October-December 2024 (Figure 1).

As such, till 31st December 2024, a total of 942 (832 Universities + 110 CFTIs/INIs) have signed MoU on Shodhganga with the INFLIBNET Centre, 15 MoUs (13 Universities + 02 CFTIs) during the reported period, increasing the number of full-text theses in Shodhganga.

Recommendations of the Newly Constituted Shodhganga National Steering Committee (SNSC)

The newly constituted Shodhganga National Steering Committee (SNSC) meeting held on 21st August 2024 recommended upgrading the existing servers with additional servers and storage spaces. As recommended for revamping to Shodhganga 2.0, the Committee tested migrating the current/existing database from Dspace 5.3 to 7.6.1.

As per the recommendations, necessary amendments are being made in the current MoU for the smooth execution of Shodhganga to deal with the embargo and the DRM/Legal issues, inclusion of plagiarism reports, student's copyright undertaking, unique researcher id's, modification of CC BY NC, One-page Plagiarism Report/Certificate/Summary Report has been made mandatory to be uploaded in Shodhganga. Policy on embargo is included in the Amendment MoU, and as vetted by the Legal expert, the MoU amendments are made along with License/Copyright issues and circulated to all the HEIs joined in Shodhganga for signing the Amendment to the MoU.

Shodhgangotri

Shodhgangotri is also now open to PG dissertations based on the request of the Ministry of Ayush. Currently, the repository hosts 15,252 Synopses/MRPs/PDFs/Fellowships/PG Dissertations contributed by 142 universities. 364 Synopses/MRPs/PDFs/Fellowship/PG Dissertations were added during the reported period.

ShodhShuddhi - Plagiarism Detection Software (PDS)

The Ministry of Education, through its initiative ShodhShuddhi, provides access to Plagiarism Detection Software (PDS) to all Universities, including Central, State, Deemed, and Private Universities, as well as Centrally funded Technical Institutions/Institutes of National Importance (CFTIs/INIs) in India through Central funding to enhance academic integrity in academic institutions and to curb plagiarism, w.e.f. 01st September 2019. In October 2023, a new PDS Software (i.e., DrillBit Extreme) was procured and provided to 1100+ HEIs. The current order is extended for one more year till October 2025 based on the evaluation Committee's recommendation under the same terms and conditions.

As of 31st December 2024, a total of 49,89,415 documents have been submitted to check similarity/plagiarism from 1149 (857 active) universities/institutions since inception. The Project Shodhshuddhi envisaged using 10 Lakhs of documents each year with 20% extra, and now 49.89 Lakhs of documents are submitted by the end of 31st December 2024.

Usage Statistics of PDS

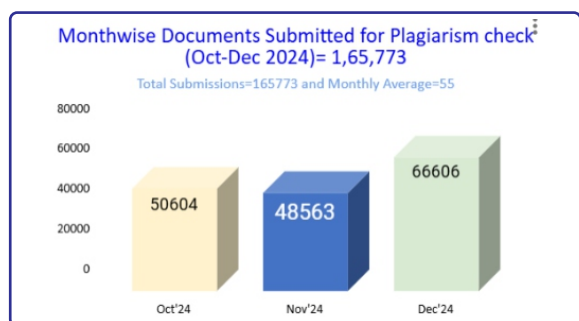


Figure 2: Nos. of Submissions[#] in PDS month-wise (Oct-Dec) 2024)

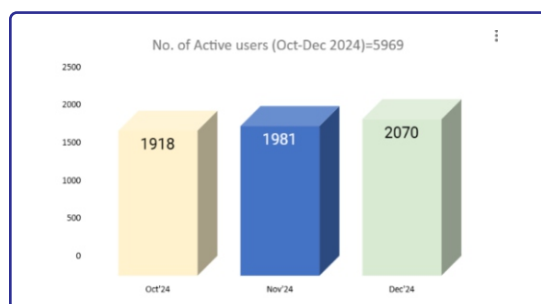


Figure 3: Shows the month-wise No. of active users during the period under report

The total submission of documents into PDS during the period under report is 1,65,773. Figure 2 shows the number of submissions in the last three months (October: 50604, November: 48563, December: 66606); the average was 55,257. Figure 3 shows the month-wise nos. of active users during the period under report.

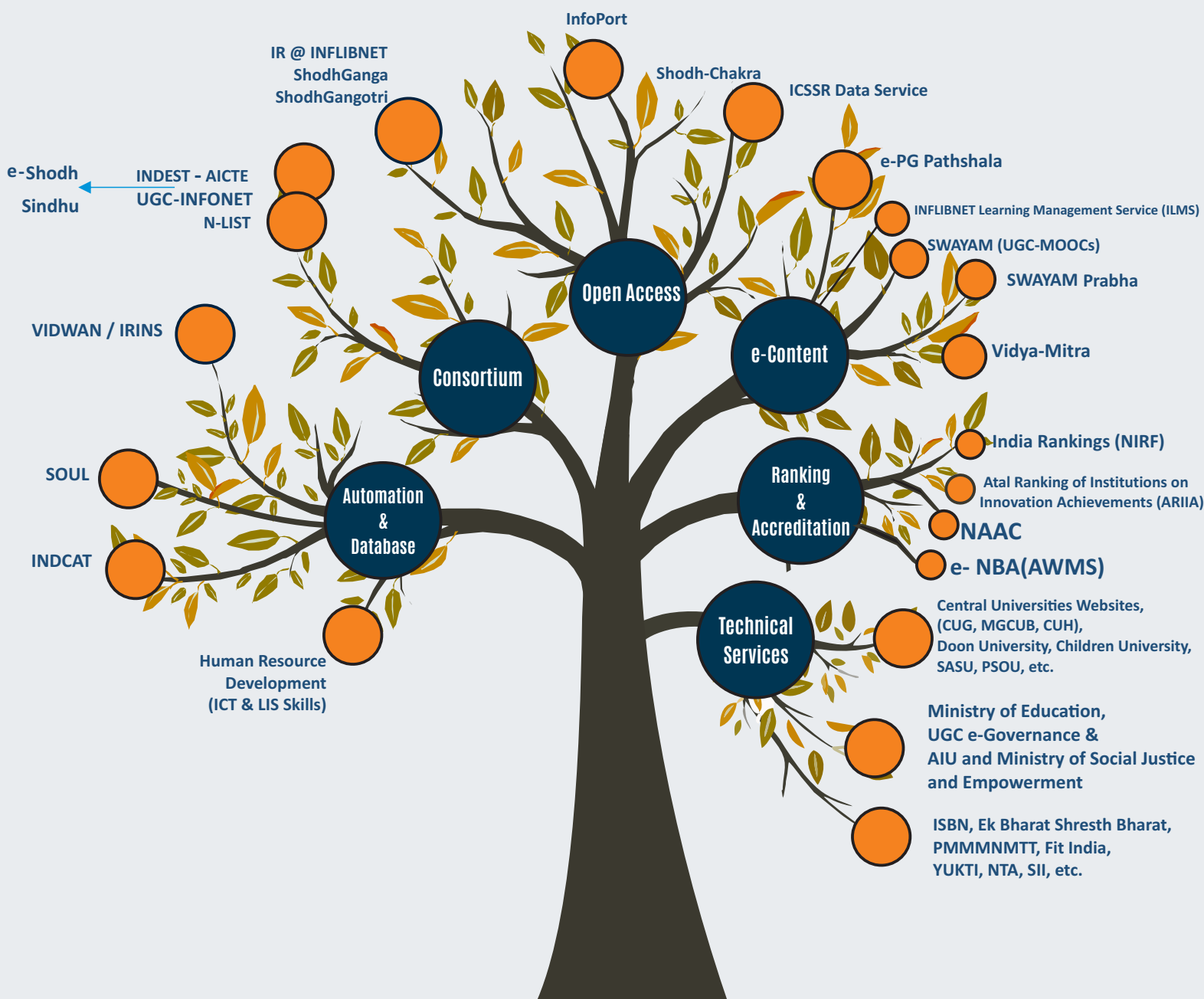
